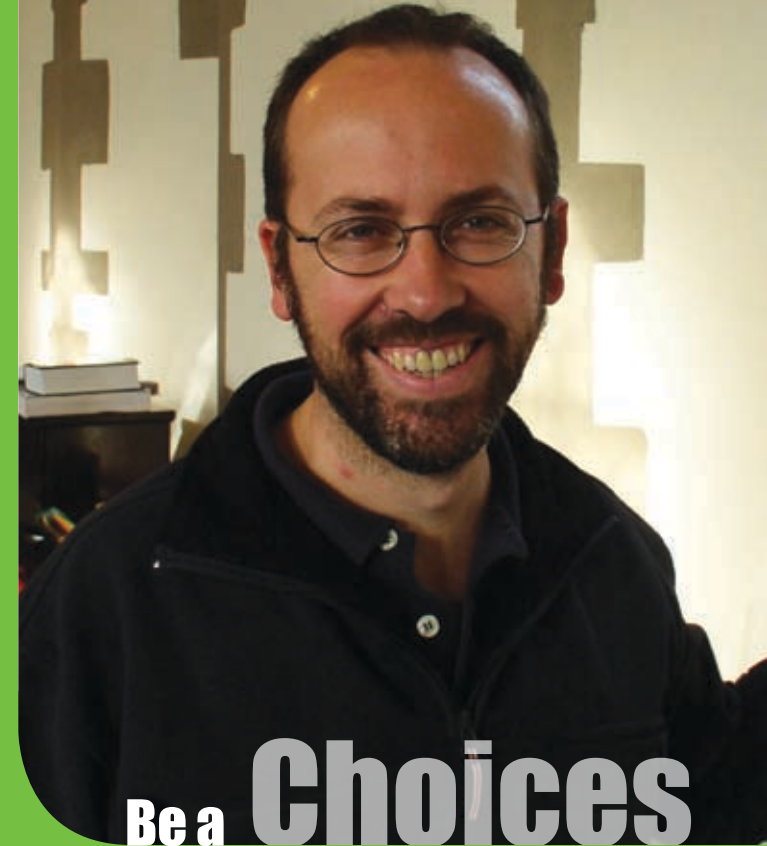

Who is Choices for?

Adults

- 1 in 6 people face clinical depression and anxiety
- Depression and anxiety are often linked to worklessness, debt, poor housing, alcohol misuse and broken relationships

Youth

- Those not in education or employment
- Poor behaviour and crime
- Low self worth is often linked to bullying, self harm, eating and drug misuse

Pre alpha

- People seeking faith are on a journey
- Choices needs to be part of a church strategy alongside befriending and faith-sharing



What is Choices?

- A practical outreach tool for churches.
- A course which helps people gain confidence, take control of their life and make life changing choices.
- Delivered by local churches and church organisations, to reach out to their communities unconditionally.



How does Choices work?

- Choices is written to be delivered by church members.
- High quality training, underpinned by psychology and theology.
- Partners are trained in gradual stages: from watching to supported training, to leading.



Why do Choices?

- People's lives are changed for good, people say it is 'life changing'.
- Church members are equipped, through putting faith into practice, being involved with needy people and seeing God at work.
- See spiritual change and progress in people.
